

Tower of Tickets get 'Trolled'

Tower of Tickets, an all-time popular revenue spinner and a classic four-player rotary redemption game is now available as an officially licensed DreamWorks Trolls version, leveraging the hugely popular franchise.



Tower of Tickets is already a proven redemption game that operators report earns well. Players time the release of the moving arm to skillfully knock the targets off the rotating playfield and onto the RFID scoring platform. The targets are read and returned to the playfield for 100 per cent contained play. Targets with tufts of DreamWorks Trolls hair on them are worth big points.

The DreamWorks Trolls version comes with additional features besides the popular licensed artwork. The marquee is developed to be powered via a ceiling power drop, as well as from the standard floor outlet below, for added flexibility.

The RFID targets are new, too. Instead of glued ticket stacks, they're injection-molded discs with bright decals adding to the game aesthetics. Tower of Tickets is manufactured in partnership with Belgium's Elaut Group.
